

CHURCH OF ST. THOMAS THE APOSTLE PRE-AUTHORIZED REMITTANCES (PAR) -- 2023

What is PAR? St. Thomas has a direct-debit arrangement known as the Pre-Authorized Remittances (PAR) program. Many Anglican parishes use this method of giving, and we encourage you to consider it.

How does it work? Simply fill in the attached PAR Authorization Form, sign it and attach a sample blank cheque from your account marked "VOID". We will send it to the United Church in Toronto that provides the service to a number of Anglican churches Canada-wide. The bank does the rest.

How much does it cost? It costs you nothing. St. Thomas' pays 50 cents monthly. If more than 90 members participate, the monthly cost to the church will stay at \$45.00. We're over 90 members at present, so as we grow the monthly cost to the church will stay the same.

When each month is the transfer made? Close to the 20th day of the month.

What if circumstances change and I wish to give more or less each month? Simply complete a revised PAR Authorization Form. Allow a month for the change to take effect. A new voided cheque is not required unless you wish to change the bank account from which the contribution is taken. How do I decide how much to give each month? In calculating the monthly equivalent of weekly offerings remember that, on average, there are 4.33 weeks per month: (52 weeks \div 12 months). Examples:

Weekly	Equivalent Monthly
Offering	Offering
15	65
50	220
100	440, etc.

What do I do with my envelopes? Use them for special offerings or appeals, or to augment your monthly PAR commitment. For 2023, you'll receive a special, smaller set of envelopes for PAR members.

What happens if I change my bank and/or bank account? Simply fill in the attached PAR Authorization Form, sign it and attach a sample blank cheque from your new account marked "VOID".

How do current PAR members change their pledge for 2023? Complete the attached PAR Authorization Form with your new pledge, WITHOUT a voided cheque, and attach it to your Response Form.
